

KEY ACHIEVEMENTS of the High Qualification Commission of Judges of Ukraine in November 2025



The qualification exam within the competition for vacant positions of judges in the High Anti-Corruption Court has been completed. The final stage has been conducted – the completion of a practical assignment in the specialisation of the High Anti-Corruption Court, in particular its Appeals Chamber, for 85 candidates. The assignments are currently being reviewed.

The ranking of candidates based on the results of the qualification assessment has been approved, and 10 winners of the competition for vacant positions of judges in the Transcarpathian Court of Appeal have been determined.

The opportunity to prepare documents in the judicial career e-cabinet for participation in competitions for 27 vacant judicial positions, 17 of which are in the Specialised Circuit Administrative Court and 10 in the Specialised Administrative Court of Appeal, is now open. The submission of documents for participation in these competitions will last from 01 to 23 December 2025 (inclusive).

The High Qualification Commission of Judges of Ukraine is implementing the practice of public presentation of regular digests in order to increase the transparency of its activities and strengthen public confidence in judicial governance bodies. The introduction of such digests is provided for in the Roadmap on the Rule of Law, a strategic document that defines the set of reforms necessary for Ukraine's accession to the European Union.
